CONSTITUTION

TITLE

The club shall be known as the Astley & Tyldesley Cycle Speedway Club, herein after referred to as the Club.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

1. To provide and promote community participation in cycle speedway racing for all interested parties, using the track located adjacent to the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club, Meanley Road, Gin Pit, Tyldesley as the Club's base.
2. To develop and foster a spirit of comradeship and loyalty to the Club and its members.
3. To promote the highest standards of sportsmanship and to uphold the sport's ruling bodies' regulations, both in letter and in spirit.
4. To develop and encourage riders to enable them to fulfill their potential, both in individual and team events.
5. To continually strive to upgrade the Club's status and facilities for the broader benefit of the sport.
6. To safeguard the future of the Club within the sport's ruling bodies' rules and regulations.
7. To ensure a duty of care to all members of the Club.
8. To ensure that all present and future members receive fair and equal treatment.

CLUB MEETINGS

The Club shall hold an annual general meeting for the election of officers who shall form the Club Committee and serve for a period of one year. Only fully paid up members are entitled to cast a vote at the annual general meeting. In addition, the Committee shall convene Club and/or Committee meetings at their discretion. Constitutional amendments shall require a two-thirds majority of persons present who are eligible to vote and can only be passed at an annual or extraordinary general meeting. Changes to rules and regulations, or any other matters arising, shall require a simple majority of persons present who are eligible to vote.

COMMITTEE

The Chairman shall head the Club.

The Secretary shall provide administrative services to the Club.

The Treasurer shall maintain the Club's accounts and be responsible for the collection of income due to the Club, and the payment of expenditure incurred by the Club.

The Team Manager(s) shall be responsible for the selection of teams for Club events, the organisation of the recruitment, training, coaching, discipline and motivation of riders, working closely with the Club's Coach(es).

The Club Captain shall liaise between the Team Manager(s) and the riders.

The Development Officer(s) shall be responsible for enhancing the status and facilities of the Club.

The Track Manager shall be responsible for the maintenance and general upkeep of the Club's facilities and equipment.

The Club Welfare Officer shall be responsible for ensuring the well-being of club members whilst participating in club activities.

The Committee shall be responsible for ensuring the efficient operation of the Club and may allocate specific duties to non-Committee members as appropriate.

Duties are described in greater detail in the Club's Job Descriptions and Match Day Officials' Duties documents.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to all interested parties without discrimination in either an administrative, competitive or supporting capacity. The Club may refuse membership or expel from membership only for good and sufficient cause, such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or sport into disrepute. Appeal against such a decision may be made to the Club's members and decided by a majority vote. All members will be subject to the regulations of the constitution and by joining the Club will be deemed to accept these regulations and codes of conduct that the Club has adopted.

CHARGES

Users shall be liable for Track Access / Equipment Hire charges, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the season. Charges will be paid per session.

FEES

An annual fee is payable for members aged 18 and over, to cover membership of the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club. Junior members aged under 18 have free membership of the Cycle Speedway Club.

All racing members shall be liable for registration, affiliation and entry fees to the sport's ruling bodies. The appropriate fees will be paid in full in advance of the competition(s). In the event of non-payment, racing members will be unable to participate in the competition(s) in question.

NON-PROFIT MAKING

All surplus income or profits are re-invested in the Club. No surpluses or assets will be distributed to members or third parties.

DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the Club, any remaining assets shall be given or transferred to another registered Community Amateur Sports Club, a registered charity or the sport's governing body, for use by them in community related sports.

Constitution approved 12th December 2007.

Chairman's Welcome – Gary Nuttall

Gary summarised the 2007 season by stating that the club had performed very well in some areas but poorly in others.

- *Disappointing performances from the senior squad, but promising prospects for the future with the junior squad.*
- *Disappointments over the club not being able to access grants for development due to excessive delays in securing a long term lease from Wigan Council.*
- *Disappointment expressed by the meeting at the poor turn-out for the AGM.*

Acceptance of the 2006 minutes

The minutes were accepted a true record.

Annual Report

The annual report was accepted by the meeting. All present were happy with the financial statement and the current balance of £1505.14. It was noted that a further £500 was still outstanding from two sponsors – Rowlands and Kensite.

Constitution and Rules

It was proposed and agreed that the rider subscriptions introduced for the past season be scrapped, as they were to cover the anticipated increase in travel costs as a result of the move into the Premier League.

- Senior members (18 years and over) to pay membership at the rate to cover membership of the A & T Miners Welfare Club.
- Junior racing members remain free.

The meeting agreed to delete the position of Social Secretary to the Club Committee.

Several other minor changes were proposed and agreed, to enable the club to comply with the requirements of HM Revenue & Customs in order to secure Community Amateur Sports Club status.

Pre-season training

Training is to commence from Sunday 3rd February 2008 onwards. It is essential that team fitness is up to scratch for the first Northern League match on Sunday 30th March 2008.

Team Line-up

A & T are welcoming back Przemek Binkowski after an absence of three seasons, for a limited number of matches. The club are exploring the possibility of other riders returning, working closely with Fred Longworth High School and British Cycling, recruiting from other cycling disciplines.

Facilities and Lease

Update provided on the continuing absence of a long term lease from Wigan Council. Many lines of enquiry have recently produced the offer of a 5 years lease, not the 25 years needed. The main effect of this is that A & T cannot access a £150,000 British Cycling Grant.

Meeting agreed to investigate the possibility of acquiring plastic tip up seats when Hilton Park, Leigh is vacated.

Meeting agreed to purchase a new small freezer for the Refreshments cabin.

Meeting closed 9.50 pm.

OFF TRACK REVIEW

After a disappointing year in 2007, the club regained its momentum of the previous years and made progress in many aspects of its operations. Several changes were made to the Committee, with Bill Phillips returning as Chairman. More club committee meetings were held during the year, as more commitment and enthusiasm came from the new Committee to drive the club forward. Brian Smith and Brian Dickenson were two welcome newcomers to the Club, who helped out considerably during the year.

The year got off to a bad start, with the news that the Facilities Development Grant offer of £150,000 from Sport England, that had been on the table since 2005, had been withdrawn. This was due to Wigan Council's Legal Department failing to draft a lease for the track site. Consequently, Mike Hack had to devote a considerable amount of time and energy in contacting key players to resolve the lease issue and to seek replacement funding. This was effort that could have been expended in other areas of activity. The lease issue has finally been resolved, although the extortionate charges imposed on the Club by the Council have left a sour taste. We are currently awaiting the outcome of a bid for £127,000 to Sport England's Community Investment Fund, so the past lack of activity from the Miners' Welfare Club and Wigan Council could still deprive us of our much needed major re-development.

On the positive side, Aimee Hack secured funding for six new club bikes from the Community Chest Fund. Good contacts were made with local MPs and developed with Wigan Leisure & Culture Trust and Sport England, as the club's profile and standing was raised. The Club was shortlisted for the CCPR's Sports Club of the Year award. Mike Hack was recognised at the Wigan Sports awards, runner-up in the Unsung Hero category, with Gary Nuttall recognised by British Cycling in receiving a Special Volunteer award. We retained three club sponsors - Aqua Clenz, CTA Direct, Hypnotherapy4you - whose support was invaluable and secured a new one in J. Fisher & Sons at the end of the year. The club successfully promoted the U-13 British Club Championship event, sponsored once again by the Astley Rotary Club. Club finances are in a healthy situation, primarily due to income received from sponsorships and match day catering. The website continues to be a valuable information and promotional portal for the club. Plenty of professional standard press releases were issued and press coverage was much improved in the Leigh press, as well as increased internet coverage and a direct link from the Leigh Journal website. The Club maintained its record level of 55 club members (40 riders and 15 officials/volunteers) and continued to be a well organised set-up.

Mike Hack drew up a comprehensive 4 years Business Plan, Development Plan and Action Plan, all necessary in order to access funding, as we seek to greatly expand our level of operations and make the most of the opportunities available to us, partly as a result of the excellent work undertaken in previous seasons. The Plans will also enable us to take advantage of the unprecedented opportunities for development, following the success of British cyclists at the 2008 Olympic Games and a strong desire to create a lasting sporting legacy in the U.K. after the 2012 Olympic Games, although the current economic climate may yet thwart many aspirations.

ON TRACK REVIEW

The club successfully recovered and stabilised in 2008, after the considerably embarrassing and unprecedented step of withdrawing from the British Premier League in mid-season in 2007.

There were much improved turn-outs at matches this time round, as the club moved up from 6th to 4th in the Northern League table. But three disappointing results were recorded, due to many first choice riders missing for the trips to Edinburgh, Hull and Heckmondwike, with once again the latter recording their only win all season against us. A hard fought win at Stoke was undoubtedly the best win of the season and underlined the quality in the squad. The squad system worked well, with two welcome secondary riders from Sheffield in Mick Knowles and Dariusz Pilas, along with two Polish based riders, Przemek Binkowski and Tomasz Sz wajorek, when commitments permitted. This enabled us to remain competitive after Tomasz Wlodarczyk returned to Poland and Darek Kurkowski missed a few matches.

The highlight was retaining the Manchester League Division 1 title, to win for the fourth time in six years. We finished 8th in the British Club Championship table, to meet our target of a top ten placing for the third successive year.

There was a much improved presence at junior competitions, with an influx of U-16 riders, notably Ben Dickenson, Luke Jamson, Ben Keen and Laura Watson, for the first time in a few years. The club welcomed plenty of new recruits, with 14 1st year riders registered with British Cycling. A new North West Go-Ride Grand Prix series proved to be successful in introducing newcomers to competitive racing and this will be extended in 2009, after home Northern League matches.

Individual highlights proved to be Adam Phillips' victory in the U-10 British Grand Prix series and finishing 2nd in the British U-10 Individual Final, whilst Remi Burchardt became the latest A & T rider to win the Manchester League Senior Individual Final.

There were plenty of good performances in individual competitions from other club riders and the regular riders can feel well pleased with their efforts. Adam Watson benefited from competing in the national rounds of the British Junior League. There is plenty of potential within the club for the youngsters to really progress in the next few seasons.

The Club is looking to develop the nucleus of a more regular team in 2009, to fully tap the ability within the squad and mount a stronger, sustained challenge in the Northern League. At the same time, it also recognises the importance of retaining the squad members to top up when necessary due to pre-planned absences.
