ASTLEY & TYLDESLEY CYCLE SPEEDWAY CLUB CONSTITUTION

TITLE

The club shall be known as the Astley & Tyldesley Cycle Speedway Club, herein after referred to as the Club.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

1. To provide and promote community participation in cycle speedway racing for all interested parties, using the track located adjacent to the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club, Meanley Road, Gin Pit, Tyldesley as the Club's base.

2. To develop and foster a spirit of comradeship and loyalty to the Club and its members.

3. To promote the highest standards of sportsmanship and to uphold the sport's ruling bodies' regulations, both in letter and in spirit.

4. To develop and encourage riders to enable them to fulfill their potential, both in individual and team events.

5. To continually strive to upgrade the Club's status and facilities for the broader benefit of the sport.

6. To safeguard the future of the Club within the sport's ruling bodies' rules and regulations.

7. To ensure a duty of care to all members of the Club.

8. To ensure that all present and future members receive fair and equal treatment.

CLUB MEETINGS

The Club shall hold an annual general meeting for the election of officers who shall form the Club Committee and serve for a period of one year. Only fully paid up members are entitled to cast a vote at the annual general meeting. In addition, the Committee shall convene Club and/or Committee meetings at their discretion. Constitutional amendments shall require a two-thirds majority of persons present who are eligible to vote and can only be passed at an annual or extraordinary general meeting. Changes to rules and regulations, or any other matters arising, shall require a simple majority of persons present who are eligible to vote.

COMMITTEE

The Chairman shall head the Club.

The Secretary shall provide administrative services to the Club.

The Treasurer shall maintain the Club's accounts and be responsible for the collection of income due to the Club, and the payment of expenditure incurred by the Club.

The Team Manager(s) shall be responsible for the selection of teams for Club events, the organisation of the recruitment, training, coaching, discipline and motivation of riders, working closely with the Club's Coach(es).

The Club Captain shall liaise between the Team Manager(s) and the riders.

The Development Officer(s) shall be responsible for enhancing the status and facilities of the Club.

The Track Manager shall be responsible for the maintenance and general upkeep of the Club's facilities and equipment.

The Club Welfare Officer shall be responsible for ensuring the well-being of club members whilst participating in club activities.

The Committee shall be responsible for ensuring the efficient operation of the Club and may allocate specific duties to non-Committee members as appropriate.

Duties are described in greater detail in the Club's Job Descriptions and Match Day Officials' Duties documents.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to all interested parties without discrimination in either an administrative, competitive or supporting capacity. The Club may refuse membership or expel from membership only for good and sufficient cause, such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or sport into disrepute. Appeal against such a decision may be made to the Club's members and decided by a majority vote. All members will be subject to the regulations of the constitution and by joining the Club will be deemed to accept these regulations and codes of conduct that the Club has adopted.

CHARGES

Users shall be liable for Track Access / Equipment Hire charges, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the season. Charges will be paid per session.

FEES

All members of the Cycle Speedway Club shall be liable for payment of a membership fee, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the season. Fees may be paid in a lump sum prior to the commencement of the season or in installments at each session or match. The annual fee for members aged 18 and over, shall include membership of the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club.

All racing members shall be liable for registration, affiliation and entry fees to the sport's ruling bodies. The appropriate fees will be paid in full in advance of the competition(s). In the event of non-payment, racing members will be unable to participate in the competition(s) in question.

NON-PROFIT MAKING

All surplus income or profits are re-invested in the Club. No surpluses or assets will be distributed to members or third parties.

DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the Club, any remaining assets shall be given or transferred to another registered Community Amateur Sports Club, a registered charity or the sport's governing body, for use by them in community related sports.

OFF TRACK REVIEW

Several changes were made to the committee, with some new faces coming on board. Regular monthly club committee meetings were held during the year, as the club strove to move forward, even though it was apparent that not all committee members were working in conjunction with each other. Linda Turnbull was elected as Secretary, with Mike Hack moving to fill the vacant Development Officer's position. Geoff Turnbull took on the Treasurer's post, whilst Alan Farrell took up the newly created Track Curator role. Lee Phillips filled the vacant post of Welfare Officer, with Will Evans taking the Tuesday night practice sessions.

Having waited for 5 years for our planned facilities re-development, due to the promised funding from Sport England and British Cycling not materialising, the club took the decision to apply to other funders for smaller grants and carry out the re-development in smaller steps. This was successful with funding from Wigan Council's Community Chest and Grassroots Grants enabling the club to purchase three good quality steel containers to replace the old ones. Hard work by a dedicated core of club volunteers saw the track surface re-laid to provide the best racing strip ever seen at Gin Pit, the seating banks refurbished, the catering cabin kitted out inside and new team shirts purchased.

The club's progress was temporarily interrupted by unprecedented levels of vandalism and malicious comments posted whenever new facilities were installed. However, the resolve of club members overcame these attacks, as we improved our facilities immensely to increase the value of our assets and won widespread praise for our excellent British Individual Finals promotion.

We welcomed a new sponsor in Tayban Development and retained J. Fisher & Sons and Hypnotherapy4you as sponsors. The club turned over a club record sum of £12,500 and made a modest surplus on the year. This was largely due to the grants received, sponsorship monies and income generated from refreshment sales at our excellently promoted four major events.

The website continues to be a valuable information and promotional portal for the club. Plenty of professional standard press releases were issued and press coverage was good. The club continued to enhance its reputation as it continued to build up its contacts within the Wigan Borough. Club founder member Mike Hack was recognised during the year, in receiving a British Cycling Event Official Award, as well as winning both the Wigan Sports Coach of the Year and the Gt. Manchester Sports Coach of the Year Awards. The club finished the season with a record level of 17 regular officials / volunteers and continued to be a well organised set-up.

The club successfully promoted the Northern Individual Championships, British Youth & Junior League National Round 1, Women's League Round 3 and the British Individual Finals. The club looks forward to promoting the British Team Finals in 2011.

ON TRACK REVIEW

The winter departure of the majority of riders who had made up the previous season's 1st team forced the club to withdraw from the Northern League Division 1. This was quickly followed by riders declaring themselves to be unavailable to compete in the Northern Combination Division, resulting in the team pulling out after riding two matches.

This situation enabled the club to further its efforts on recruiting and coaching of youngsters, rather than expend energy in chasing up riders to make up teams to fulfill league commitments. This was shown with high numbers of riders regularly turning out at club training nights and 48 riders (albeit including some from visiting clubs) competing in the North West Go-Race Grand Prix series.

The club continued to cater for a wide range of rider (and parental) requirements, with some prepared to train and / or compete at Gin Pit only, some prepared to turn out on mid week nights only, some prepared to travel no further than Bury and Stockport, through to those who wished to train and race on a regular basis both in regional and national competitions. Riders were also able to compete in Manchester League Division 1 events, to enable riders to compete in some senior matches.

Some good results were recorded at junior levels, with the club finishing 3rd in the Northern section of the British Youth & Junior League, 2nd in the Northern Junior League and 2nd in the Manchester League 2nd Division. The club finished 14th in the overall British Club Championship table, an improvement on the previous season, coming in as the 2nd highest Northern club.

Individually, we had four riders who qualified for the national rounds of the British Youth & Junior League, with Max Evans finishing 3rd in the U-8 Grand Prix series. Matthew Turnbull won the U-19 Northern Grand Prix series, whilst Adam Turnbull won both the U-10 Northern Grand Prix series and the U-10 Manchester League Grand Prix series. Adam Phillips won both the U-13 Manchester League Individual Final and the U-13 Manchester League Grand Prix series.
