ASTLEY & TYLDESLEY CYCLING CLUB CONSTITUTION

TITLE

The club shall be known as the Astley & Tyldesley Cycling Club, herein after referred to as the Club.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

1. To provide and promote community participation in cycle speedway racing for all interested parties, using the track located adjacent to the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club, Meanley Road, Gin Pit, Tyldesley as the Club's base.
2. To organize and promote community participation in leisure cycle riding for all interested parties.
3. To develop and foster a spirit of comradeship and loyalty to the Club and its members.
4. To promote the highest standards of sportsmanship and to uphold the sport's ruling bodies' regulations, both in letter and in spirit.
5. To develop and encourage riders to enable them to fulfill their potential, both in individual and team events.
6. To continually strive to upgrade the Club's status and facilities for the broader benefit of the sport.
7. To safeguard the future of the Club within the sport's ruling bodies' rules and regulations.
8. To ensure a duty of care to all members of the Club.
9. To ensure that all present and future members receive fair and equal treatment.

CLUB MEETINGS

The Club shall hold an annual general meeting for the election of officers who shall form the Club Committee and serve for a period of one year. Only fully paid up members are entitled to cast a vote at the annual general meeting. In addition, the Committee shall convene Club and/or Committee meetings at their discretion. Constitutional amendments shall require a two-thirds majority of persons present who are eligible to vote and can only be passed at an annual or extraordinary general meeting. Changes to rules and regulations, or any other matters arising, shall require a simple majority of persons present who are eligible to vote. A Club meeting will be inquorate and therefore not take place if there are less than three individuals present.

COMMITTEE

The Chairman shall head the Club.

The Vice Chairman shall deputise for the Chairman in his absence.

The Secretary shall provide administrative services to the Club.

The Treasurer shall maintain the Club's accounts and be responsible for the collection of income due to the Club, and the payment of expenditure incurred by the Club.

The Team Manager(s) shall be responsible for the selection of teams for Club events, the organization of the recruitment, training, coaching, discipline and motivation of riders, working closely with the Club's Coach(es).

The Club Captain shall liaise between the Team Manager(s) and the riders.

The Development Officer(s) shall be responsible for enhancing the status and facilities of the Club.

The Facilities Manager shall be responsible for the maintenance and general upkeep of the Club's facilities and equipment.

The Track Curator shall be responsible for the maintenance and general upkeep of the Club's race circuit.

The Club Welfare Officer(s) shall be responsible for ensuring the well-being of club members whilst participating in club activities.

The Social Secretary(s) shall be responsible for the organization of social and fund raising events.

The Committee shall be responsible for ensuring the efficient operation of the Club and may allocate specific duties to non-Committee members as appropriate. Duties are described in greater detail in the Club's Job Descriptions and Match Day Officials' Duties documents. Club members, or members of their family or friends, are required to assist with the running of events at Gin Pit, as directed by the Club Committee.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to all interested parties without discrimination in either an administrative, competitive, leisure or supporting capacity. The Club may refuse membership or expel from membership only for good and sufficient cause, such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or sport into disrepute. Appeal against such a decision may be made to the Club's members and decided by a majority vote. All members will be subject to the regulations of the constitution and by joining the Club will be deemed to accept these regulations and codes of conduct that the Club has adopted.

CHARGES

Users shall be liable for Track Access / Equipment Hire charges, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the season. Charges will be paid per session.

FEES

All members of the Club shall be liable for payment of a membership fee, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the racing season. Fees may be paid in a lump sum prior to the commencement of the racing season or in installments at each session or match. The annual fee for members aged 18 and over, shall include membership of the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club.

All racing members shall be liable for registration, affiliation and entry fees to the sport's ruling bodies. The appropriate fees will be paid in full in advance of the competition(s). In the event of non-payment, racing members will be unable to participate in the competition(s) in question.

NON-PROFIT MAKING

All surplus income or profits are re-invested in the Club. No surpluses or assets will be distributed to members or third parties.

DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the Club, any remaining assets shall be given or transferred to another registered Community Amateur Sports Club, a registered charity or the sport's governing body, for use by them in community related sports.

1. Chairman's Welcome

Bill Phillips, Chairman, welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Will Evans agreed to Chair the meeting and Catherine White to prepare minutes.

2. Confirmation of persons entitled to vote

All members present were entitled to vote in their role of member or parent of a member.

Mr Mark Brundett was the only individual in attendance that was not a member.

3. Minutes of the Annual General Meeting 2016 and Matters arising from the minutes.

Members **AGREED** the minutes of the AGM in 2016

There were no matters arising.

4. Financial Report 2017

The Treasurer circulated at the meeting the balance sheet and summary report of expenditure for the financial year 2016/17. In summary:

Income: £14,151.74

Expenditure: £13,023.26

Surplus: £1,128.48

In addition to the report findings:

Grants to support members with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities to access the sport was discussed. There was confirmation that a bid had been submitted to 'The Deal Community Fund' towards the cost of a portacabin for a multipurpose space/ladies changing room.

ACTION: Development Officer and Treasurer to follow up funding opportunities.

The cost and number of trophies for the Awards in December was anticipated to high this year and the Treasurer expected a loss on the event. Members **NOTED** that this was a reflection of a successful year on the track.

5. Review of the Year

Members **NOTED** that 2017 had been a very successful year for the Club both on and off the track.

Northern League Division One - Champions. (Lee Phillips, Team Manager)

- Great success and teamwork in winning the League.
- However, there was no updated table of results.
- Northern League Committee had upheld the decision regarding an A&T junior rider receiving a red card. Members **NOTED** that this situation had been very challenging for the family and club.
- Concern was expressed over the viability of local clubs and the need for strong competition.

Northern League Division Two – Champions. (Janine Paine, Team Manager)

- Very tight competition with all riders excelling. Championship came down to the last match.
- Members discussed the value of the Northern Fours competition.

Cabin

- Very successful income generator for the club (refer to Finance report).
- June and Bill Phillips standing down for match days. **ACTION:** Cabin Volunteer required.
- One parent had expressed an interest in volunteering in the cabin.
- Janine Paine happy to continue with club nights (with ad hoc support from other members).
- Members **NOTED** the success of the Halloween / Bonfire Event.
- Deep Clean of Cabin for 'overwintering' required.

Junior Team (Will Evans, Team Manager)

- Consistency in number of riders and performance resulting in another Division Three Championship and Division Two Manchester League Championship
- Members discussed the challenge of Division Three being 'third' on match days and the difficulties managing parents and riders scheduling, especially for long trips (Scotland). **ACTION:** Propose that Division 3 starts at 1pm to encourage more riders to attend.
- British Youth and Junior League (and Little League) had low attendance regionally and nationally by Northern riders, but A&T riders performed well with two riders in under 8 in the top five, a number of under 10 qualifying for finals and one rider winning their third British Grand Prix title (under 12). Members discussed the individual and team nature of the competition and its value. **AGREED:** Catherine White to support Junior Team Manager and become BJYL Team Manager
- Increasing profile of female riders, with one junior rider excelling at the national level.

6. Constitution and Rules

Members **AGREED** the circulated constitution with no proposed changes.

Cabin

ACTION: New volunteers for cabin required. People need food and hygiene certificate. Need to be clear of roles: buyer, cleaner, etc.

AOB

A committee member expressed disappointment that more committee members didn't support an application for the Euro club championships.

ACTION: Review of communication to club members as a mass of emails can be too much.

Members discussed how club can support riders financially and how riders can apply to the club for support and money raisers.

Members **NOTED** the support and hard work of Mike Hack and noted this was the first AGM he had missed. We wish him the best and a very speedy recovery.

OFF TRACK REVIEW

The Club started the year with previous partners Blackmoor Service Station, CTA Direct, Crown Sports, D. & M. Burgess Joiners and SMD Tyres all renewing. Four new partners were welcomed - Atherton Physiotherapy & Sports Injury Clinic, Icon Embroidery, PG Bell Electrical and SAM Joinery. The Rotary Club of Astley and 33/18 Designs sponsored major events. Kelly Skitterall joined the Committee as Assistant Treasurer and a Social Secretary.

Early in the year, it was announced that the Club had won British Cycling's Go-Ride Club of the Year 2017 award - a magnificent achievement to come first out of 370 clubs nationally. John White was successful in receiving Believe Talent funding from Wigan Council. We achieved a 5 star rating from Wigan Council for food hygiene at our refreshments cabin. Later in the year, we obtained £3,000 from Wigan Council's Brighter Borough Fund, thanks to our local Councillors, and £1,000 from Forever Manchester, to fund six full size bikes and three sets of jerseys for the new A&T Go-Ride Racing League. We finished the year by winning the Wigan Sports Club of the Year award for the third time. The club successfully renewed its Sport England Clubmark accreditation for another three years, held continuously since 2005.

The club generated income of £17,116 making a surplus of £1,912 on the year, to leave a balance of £7,701. The income was largely due to subscriptions and refreshment sales at our club nights and on match days, as well as from grants, partnership revenues generated, plus hire of the facilities to external groups. We successfully promoted a round of the Battle of Britain series, a British Club Championship day and a British Individual Finals day. We also staged a round of the North West Youth League and the North & Scotland Regional Final of the British Cycle Speedway Cup.

The website, administration and press releases continued to ensure that communications were sound, both within the club and to an outside audience. This was enhanced with the club's Facebook page, Youtube account, Twitter account, WhatsApp messaging and a new Instagram account. The club continued to develop its local contacts and paid host to taster sessions from several organisations. Cycle speedway was again staged as part of the Atherton & Tyldesley Sports Association's 2017/18 primary schools programme. We started a new Satellite Club link with Fred Longworth High School, which generated several new recruits.

We continued to recruit and develop riders at the weekly club nights. We made big strides in recruiting female riders to compete in matches as well as training sessions. We finished the year with 87 cycle speedway riders, (27 members and 60 casuals). The Road section and Off Road section, led by Nic and Lynne Yates, featured casual users. A new development saw riders represent our club in other cycling discipline events, with riders taking part in cyclo-cross races. The club finished the season with a further 24 regular officials / volunteers, to give a total of 113 members. The club continued to be a well organised set-up, with a friendly and welcoming environment.

ON TRACK REVIEW

The Club enjoyed another highly successful season on the track in 2018. Led by Lee Phillips, the 1st team retained the Northern League Division 1 title, with a 100% record. This was followed up with another win in the Northern Regional Final to qualify for the British Cycle Speedway Cup Final, where we put in an improved performance from last year. Key to the club's success were veteran Steve Harris, who signed from Swindon, and was our top scorer over the season, and former Heckmondwike rider, Pawel Idziorek, along with the previous year's squad. The 1st team were unlucky not to win the Northern Cup Final, losing a 1st place run-off to Hull. We were again close to winning the Northern Fours League title, winning three out of four matches in the series. The club made its first appearance in the European Club Championships at East Park and finished 7th, out of 20 teams. We recorded our highest position, 5th, in the British Club Championship, to show our strength throughout the club, with 3rd place finishes by our Veterans team and new Women's and u-16 Girls teams. We finished 2nd to Stockport in the Manchester League Division 1 series.

We made a good start to our defence of the Northern League Division 2 title. However, with riders missing for key matches, Janine Paine's team lost four matches and ended up as runners-up.

The club really excelled at junior levels again. Under the guidance of new British Youth & Junior League and Little League Team Manager Catherine White, the club again qualified for the national series of the BYJL, after winning the Northern group of both the BYJL and the LL. In the national BYJL series, the team finished 4th, our best finish for 20 years. The u-13 team won the Northern League Division 3 title for the sixth successive year. The juniors won the Manchester League Division 2 title for the fifth successive year and won the Northern Junior League for the second successive season.

Individually our riders more than showed their ability. A&T had more riders winning medals at the British Finals Weekend than any other club. Nationally, John White collected his 5th British title, when retaining the u-12 British Grand Prix series and winning the British u-12 Boys Final. Emily Burgess had an immense season at Women's and Girls racing, winning both the u-14 and u-16 Girls British Finals and finishing 2nd in the Women's Open British Final, at the age of 14. Steve Harris extended his all time record of British Individual title wins, by winning the o-50 title. In the North & Scotland regional competitions, we had three Individual Final winners, as Fraser Brundrett won the u-10 Individual Final, John White the u-13 title and Paul Graham the Veterans event. We had three Grand Prix series winners, as Pawel Idziorek won the Division 1 series, Emily Burgess the Women's series and Mick Knowles the Division 2 series. We dominated the winners in the Manchester League championships, with Reece Pollitt winning the Senior Individual Final and Grand Prix series, Ciaran Collins the u-19 GP series, Max Evans the u-16 Final, John White the u-13 Final, Tom Morrissey the u-13 GP series, Fraser Brundrett the u-10 Final and Duncan Whalley the u-10 GP series.

Our riders were to the fore in the Battle of Britain series, representing the North & Scotland team. Mike Hack was the senior team manager and we had six riders racing for the senior team, with two in the junior team. Emily Burgess top scored for the North, Scotland, South East & East team which won the Women's League competition.

Internationally, Ciaran Collins raced for Ireland at both senior and junior international level. Emily Burgess and Max Evans made their debuts for the England Junior team.

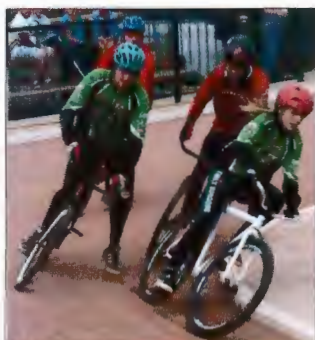

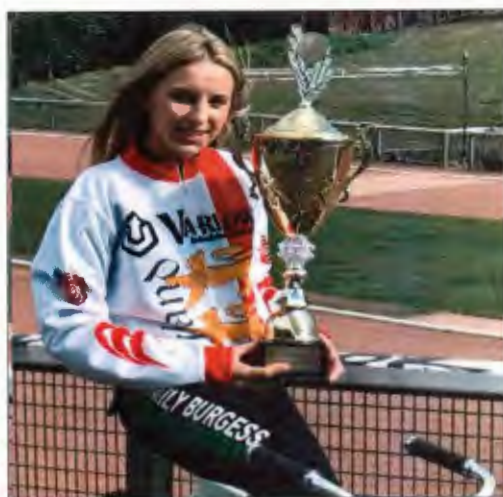
