ASTLEY & TYLDESLEY CYCLING CLUB CONSTITUTION

TITLE

The club shall be known as the Astley & Tyldesley Cycling Club, herein after referred to as the Club.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

1. To provide and promote community participation in cycle speedway racing for all interested parties, using the track located adjacent to the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club, Meanley Road, Gin Pit, Tyldesley as the Club's base.
2. To organize and promote community participation in leisure cycling for all interested parties.
3. To enable club members to represent the Club in race events in all cycling disciplines.
4. To develop and foster a spirit of comradeship and loyalty to the Club and its members.
5. To promote the highest standards of sportsmanship and to uphold the sport's ruling bodies' regulations, both in letter and in spirit.
6. To develop and encourage riders to enable them to fulfill their potential, both in individual and team events.
7. To continually strive to upgrade the Club's status and facilities for the broader benefit of the sport.
8. To safeguard the future of the Club within the sport's ruling bodies' rules and regulations.
9. To ensure a duty of care to all members of the Club.
10. To ensure that all present and future members receive fair and equal treatment.

CLUB MEETINGS

The Club shall hold an annual general meeting for the election of officers who shall form the Club Committee and serve for a period of one year. Only fully paid up members are entitled to cast a vote at the annual general meeting. In addition, the Committee shall convene Club and/or Committee meetings at their discretion. Constitutional amendments shall require a two-thirds majority of persons present who are eligible to vote and can only be passed at an annual or extraordinary general meeting. Changes to rules and regulations, or any other matters arising, shall require a simple majority of persons present who are eligible to vote. A Club meeting will be inquorate and therefore not take place if there are less than three individuals present.

COMMITTEE

The Chairman shall head the Club.

The Vice Chairman shall deputise for the Chairman in his absence.

The Secretary shall provide administrative services to the Club.

The Treasurer shall maintain the Club's accounts and be responsible for the collection of income due to the Club, and the payment of expenditure incurred by the Club.

The Team Manager(s) shall be responsible for the selection of teams for Club events, the organization of the recruitment, training, coaching, discipline and motivation of riders, working closely with the Club's Coach(es).

The Club Captain shall liaise between the Team Manager(s) and the riders.

The Development Officer(s) shall be responsible for enhancing the status and facilities of the Club.

The Facilities Manager shall be responsible for the maintenance and general upkeep of the Club's facilities and equipment.

The Track Curator shall be responsible for the maintenance and general upkeep of the Club's race circuit.

The Club Welfare Officer(s) shall be responsible for ensuring the well-being of club members whilst participating in club activities.

The Social Secretary(s) shall be responsible for the organization of social and fund raising events.

ASTLEY & TYLDESLEY CYCLING CLUB CONSTITUTION

The Committee shall be responsible for ensuring the efficient operation of the Club and may allocate specific duties to non-Committee members as appropriate. Duties are described in greater detail in the Club's Job Descriptions and Match Day Officials' Duties documents. Club members, or members of their family or friends, are required to assist with the running of events at Gin Pit, as directed by the Club Committee.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to all interested parties without discrimination in either an administrative, competitive, leisure or supporting capacity. The Club may refuse membership or expel from membership only for good and sufficient cause, such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or sport into disrepute. Appeal against such a decision may be made to the Club's members and decided by a majority vote. All members will be subject to the regulations of the constitution and by joining the Club will be deemed to accept these regulations and codes of conduct that the Club has adopted.

CHARGES

Users shall be liable for Track Access / Equipment Hire charges, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the season. Charges will be paid per session.

FEES

All members of the Club shall be liable for payment of a membership fee, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the racing season. Fees may be paid in a lump sum prior to the commencement of the racing season or in installments at each session or match. The annual fee for members aged 18 and over, shall include membership of the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club.

All racing members shall be liable for registration, affiliation and entry fees to the sport's ruling bodies. The appropriate fees will be paid in full in advance of the competition(s). In the event of non-payment, racing members will be unable to participate in the competition(s) in question.

NON-PROFIT MAKING

All surplus income or profits are re-invested in the Club. No surpluses or assets will be distributed to members or third parties.

DISSOLUTION



Review of the Year and Financial Report 2018

General discussion took place of the year's activities, both on and off the track.

Meeting pleased with league title wins in North & Scotland League Divisions 1 & 3, Northern Junior League and Manchester League Division 2.

Highlights of the year included: winning British Cycling's Go-Ride Club of the Year and Wigan Sports Club of the Year awards; strong performances in the European Club Championships; a good turn out of members for the European Championships in Poland; qualifying for the CS National Cup Final again; four British Individual title winners; another British Grand Prix title winner within the club.

Meeting agreed that the Club needs to focus on recruitment and retention of teenagers.

Meeting accepted the Financial Report, noting that the club holds a balance of £7,700 having generated a surplus of £1,912 over the year.

Meeting agreed to increase the Reserve level held from £1,500 to £2,000.

Meeting agreed to the outgoing Treasurer's recommendation of no increase in annual subscriptions payable for 2019. Thanks go to Catherine White for her sterling efforts as Treasurer over the past three years.

OFF TRACK REVIEW

The Club started the year with previous partners Atherton Physiotherapy & Sports Injury Clinic, Blackmoor Service Station, CTA Direct, Crown Sports, D. & M. Burgess Joiners, Icon Embroidery, and SMD Tyres all renewing. Long serving Coach Will Evans and Treasurer Catherine White resigned their posts, but Andrew Cox and Chaz Whalley came on board as Committee members.

John White and Emily Burgess were both successful in receiving Believe Talent funding from Wigan Council. Club founder Mike Hack received the David Saunders Memorial Trophy from the British Cycling Board for services to cycling. Support was received from the Miners' Welfare Club and the Rotary Club of Astley, to help our riders participate in international and national championships. The Club's younger riders were smartly kitted out in the new team racing tops for the A&T Go-Ride Racing League, kindly provided by Wigan Council's Brighter Borough fund. We improved our facilities at the end of the year, with the acquisition of a new cabin, to serve as a clubroom and to enable riders to train indoors on the club's spinning bikes, in winter and bad weather conditions.

The club generated income of £10,783, the cabin purchase contributed mainly to a deficit of £4,999 on the year, to leave a balance of £4,701. The income was largely due to subscriptions and refreshment sales at our club nights and on match days, as well as from grants, partnership revenues generated, plus hire of the facilities to external groups. We successfully promoted a round of the British Women's League, a round of the Battle of Britain series and the British Cycle Speedway Cup Final. We also staged the North & Scotland Individual Championship Finals and the Regional Final of the British Cycle Speedway Cup.

The website, administration and press releases continued to ensure that communications were sound, both within the club and to an outside audience. This was enhanced with the club's Facebook page, Youtube account, Twitter account, Instagram account and WhatsApp messaging. The club continued to develop its local contacts and paid host to taster sessions from several organisations. Cycle speedway was again staged as part of the Atherton & Tyldesley Sports Association's 2018/19 primary schools programme.

Recruitment of new riders was down on previous years, but the development of our riders at the weekly club nights coincided with the club's most successful on track season ever. We made progress with female riders competing in matches as well as training sessions. We finished the year with 67 cycle speedway riders, down from 87 in 2018. However, full members rose from 27 the previous year to 35, but casual members dropped from 60 to 32. The Road section and Off Road section, led by Nic and Lynne Yates, featured another 15 casual users. We also had riders represent our club in other cycling discipline events, with riders taking part in cyclo-cross races. The club finished the season with a further 20 regular officials/ volunteers, to give a total of 102 members, down from 113 in 2018. The club continued to be a well organised set-up, with a friendly and welcoming environment.

ON TRACK REVIEW

The Club enjoyed it's most successful season ever on the track in 2019. We won eight of the nine team competitions on offer to us in the North & Scotland region. After 30 years as a club, we have now reached the status of being undisputed top dogs in the Region, at every level.

Led by Lee Phillips, the 1st team won the North & Scotland League Division 1 title, for the third successive year. This was followed up with another win in the Northern Regional Final to qualify for the British Cycle Speedway Cup Final, where we narrowly missed out on finishing 2nd. We won the Northern Fours League for the first time ever and won the Manchester League Division 1, for the first time since 2008. The only trophy to elude us was the North & Scotland K.O. Cup, when we finished 2nd to Edinburgh.

We enjoyed two last gasp wins over defending champions Fife, to regain the North & Scotland League Division 2 title. Janine Paine's team won the title after a last heat decider in the Play-off at Northumbria.

The club really excelled at junior levels again. In the British Club Championship, our u-16 Girls team finished in 3rd place. Under the guidance of new Junior Team Manager Chaz Whalley, the club again qualified for the national series of the BYJL, after winning the North & Scotland group of both the BYJL and the LL. In the national BYJL series, the team finished 3rd, our best finish for over 20 years. The u-13 team won the Northern League Division 3 title for the seventh successive year. The juniors won the Manchester League Division 2 title for the sixth successive year the Northern Junior League for the third successive season and the North & Scotland Junior K.O. Cup.

Individually our riders once again more than showed their ability. Emily Burgess became the club's first ever World Champion, when she won the World u-16 Girls title in Poland, She then finished 2nd in the Women's Open World Final, at the age of 15. Nationally, Steve Harris extended his all time record of British Individual title wins to 19, with two o-50 title wins. Emily Burgess won the British Girls Grand Prix series and Frank White won both the Little League u-8 Final and Grand Prix series. Frank won every race of the season at u-8 level! In the North & Scotland regional competitions, we had four Individual Final winners, as John White won both the u-13 and u-16 titles, Steve Harris the Veterans event and Emily Burgess the Women's Final. Reece Pollitt won the Division 1 Grand Prix series. We dominated the winners in the Manchester League championships, with Emily Burgess winning the inaugural Women's Individual Final and Grand Prix series, Ciaran Collins the u-19 GP series, Emily Burgess the u-16 Final, Tom Morrissey the u-13 Final and GP series, Frank White the u-10 Final and Aiden Green the u-10 GP series.

Our riders were to the fore in the Battle of Britain series, representing the North & Scotland team. Mike Hack was the senior team manager and we had four riders racing for the senior team, with two in the junior team. Emily Burgess top scored for the North, Scotland, South East & East team which again won the Women's League competition.

Internationally, Emily Burgess and Steve Harris were both members of the England teams which won the World Cup at Women's and Veterans categories respectively. They repeated the feat for Gt. Britain in the ICSF Federations Cups. Emily raced unbeaten to top score in both her matches.
