# **ASTLEY & TYLDESLEY CYCLING CLUB CONSTITUTION**

## **TITLE**

The club shall be known as the Astley & Tyldesley Cycling Club, herein after referred to as the Club.

## **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES**

1. To provide and promote community participation in cycle speedway racing for all interested parties, using the track located adjacent to the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club, Meanley Road, Gin Pit, Tyldesley as the Club's base.
2. To organize and promote community participation in leisure cycling for all interested parties.
3. To enable club members to represent the Club in race events in all cycling disciplines.
4. To develop and foster a spirit of comradeship and loyalty to the Club and its members.
5. To promote the highest standards of sportsmanship and to uphold the sport's ruling bodies' regulations, both in letter and in spirit.
6. To develop and encourage riders to enable them to fulfill their potential, both in individual and team events.
7. To continually strive to upgrade the Club's status and facilities for the broader benefit of the sport.
8. To safeguard the future of the Club within the sport's ruling bodies' rules and regulations.
9. To ensure a duty of care to all members of the Club.
10. To ensure that all present and future members receive fair and equal treatment.

## **CLUB MEETINGS**

The Club shall hold an annual general meeting for the election of officers who shall form the Club Committee and serve for a period of one year. Only fully paid up members are entitled to cast a vote at the annual general meeting. In addition, the Committee shall convene Club and/or Committee meetings at their discretion. Constitutional amendments shall require a two-thirds majority of persons present who are eligible to vote and can only be passed at an annual or extraordinary general meeting. Changes to rules and regulations, or any other matters arising, shall require a simple majority of persons present who are eligible to vote. A Club meeting will be inquorate and therefore not take place if there are less than three individuals present.

## **COMMITTEE**

The Chairman shall head the Club.

The Vice Chairman shall deputise for the Chairman in his absence.

The Secretary shall provide administrative services to the Club.

The Treasurer shall maintain the Club's accounts and be responsible for the collection of income due to the Club, and the payment of expenditure incurred by the Club.

The Team Manager(s) shall be responsible for the selection of teams for Club events, the organization of the recruitment, training, coaching, discipline and motivation of riders, working closely with the Club's Coach(es).

The Club Captain shall liaise between the Team Manager(s) and the riders.

The Development Officer(s) shall be responsible for enhancing the status and facilities of the Club.

The Facilities Manager shall be responsible for the maintenance and general upkeep of the Club's facilities and equipment.

The Track Curator shall be responsible for the maintenance and general upkeep of the Club's race circuit.

The Club Welfare Officer(s) shall be responsible for ensuring the well-being of club members whilst participating in club activities.

The Social Secretary(s) shall be responsible for the organization of social and fund raising events.

# **ASTLEY & TYLDESLEY CYCLING CLUB CONSTITUTION**

The Committee shall be responsible for ensuring the efficient operation of the Club and may allocate specific duties to non-Committee members as appropriate. Duties are described in greater detail in the Club's Job Descriptions and Match Day Officials' Duties documents. Club members, or members of their family or friends, are required to assist with the running of events at Gin Pit, as directed by the Club Committee.

## **MEMBERSHIP**

Membership shall be open to all interested parties without discrimination in either an administrative, competitive, leisure or supporting capacity. The Club may refuse membership or expel from membership only for good and sufficient cause, such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or sport into disrepute. Appeal against such a decision may be made to the Club's members and decided by a majority vote. All members will be subject to the regulations of the constitution and by joining the Club will be deemed to accept these regulations and codes of conduct that the Club has adopted.

## **CHARGES**

Users shall be liable for Track Access / Equipment Hire charges, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the season. Charges will be paid per session.

## **FEES**

All members of the Club shall be liable for payment of a membership fee, which will be set by the Committee before the commencement of the racing season. Fees may be paid in a lump sum prior to the commencement of the racing season or in installments at each session or match. The annual fee for members aged 18 and over, shall include membership of the Astley & Tyldesley Miners' Welfare Club.

All racing members shall be liable for registration, affiliation and entry fees to the sport's ruling bodies. The appropriate fees will be paid in full in advance of the competition(s). In the event of non-payment, racing members will be unable to participate in the competition(s) in question.

## **NON-PROFIT MAKING**

All surplus income or profits are re-invested in the Club. No surpluses or assets will be distributed to members or third parties.

## **DISSOLUTION**


Upon dissolution of the Club, any remaining assets shall be given or transferred to another registered Community Amateur Sports Club, a registered charity or the sport's governing body, for use by them in community related sports.

### **Review of the Year and Financial Report 2019**

General discussion took place of the year's activities, both on and off the track.

Despite some off track difficulties, following the resignations of two key officials and domestic issues reducing the input from another one, on the track the club enjoyed the most successful season in its 30 years history.

Meeting delighted with wins in North & Scotland League Divisions 1, 2 & 3, Northern Fours & Junior Leagues, N&S Junior Cup and Manchester League Divisions 1 & 2.

Highlights of the year included: taking third place in the CS National Cup Final; one World Individual champion; two World Cup winners; two British Individual title winners; two British Grand Prix title winners within the club.

The three weeks gap for the World Championships disrupted the continuity of sessions in mid-season.

Success from increased number of followers on social media sites.

Meeting accepted the Financial Report, noting that the club holds a balance of £4,941.

The year's surplus has enabled the club to spend £3,500 on a new cabin.

LP announced that he was standing down as 1<sup>st</sup> Team manager.

## **OFF TRACK REVIEW**

The Club had planned to celebrate the 30th season of racing at Gin Pit, with several events during the year. However, the Covid-19 pandemic greatly curtailed the club's activities in every way, from March onwards. This affected revenues from sponsorship, advertising, weekly subscriptions, hire charges and catering sales, as well as committee meetings, social events, matches and club training nights.

The Club started the year with the previous partners renewing. Cycle Direct had come on board at the end of the previous year, by providing a maintenance service for the club's stock of bikes. Bill Phillips stepped down as Chairman, after being at the helm for the previous 12 seasons, along with an earlier spell of 6 years. Bill was made Honorary President in recognition of his services to the Club. Lee Phillips also stepped down as 1st team manager, after a highly successful three year stint. Steve Harris was elected as both Chairman and 1st team manager for 2020.

There was disappointment as the Club's application to British Cycling's Places to Ride fund, to complete the track construction works of 2016, was unsuccessful. However, we did receive a Discretionary Grant of £2,500 from Wigan Council, to compensate for reduced income, due to the pandemic. A similar bid of £1,000 to the Forever Manchester Fund was unsuccessful.

The club generated income of £6,292, to leave a balance of £5,325.

Facility works saw the external painting of the new Clubroom cabin and the treating of the banks of spectator seating.

Just two new riders were recruited prior to the four months suspension of club activities in March. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, the club took the decision not to actively recruit new members for the rest of the year, but to ensure that those existing riders who wished to resume, were able to do so in a safe environment, fully compliant with government regulations. Approximately half the club members who were active prior to the pandemic returned to the club, when weekly sessions were resumed in July.

Our main aim next season is to actively encourage existing members to return, whilst embarking on a strong recruitment programme for new riders and volunteers. The storage cabin is also in need of replacing, with additional changing facilities required.

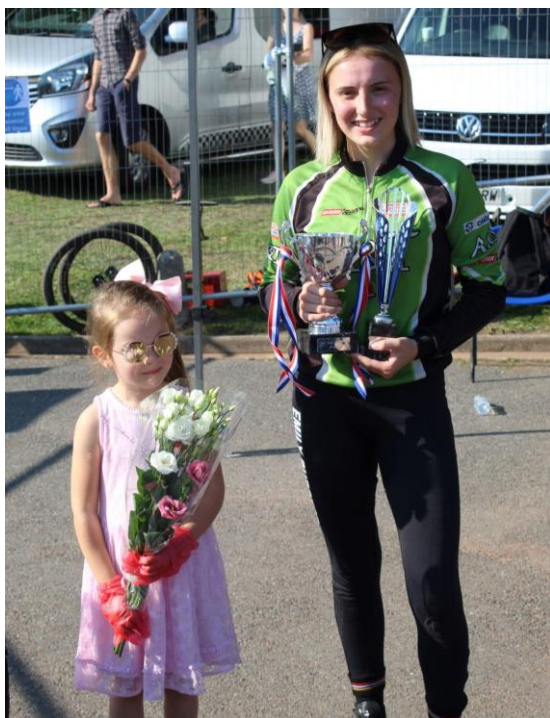
## **ON TRACK REVIEW**

Lee Phillips stepped down as team manager, at the end of the 2019 season, after a highly successful three years at the helm, delivering three successive North & Scotland League Division 1 titles. The vastly experienced Steve Harris replaced him, and declared an intention to promote some of the club's highly promising junior riders to the 1st team, so as not to stifle their progress. The squad prepared hard for the new season, with the usual six weeks' pre-season on track training regime.

However, the 2020 racing season was decimated, as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic. The club entertained Edinburgh and Sheffield on the opening day of the season, in five North & Scotland League matches, before all regional matches were suspended for the remainder of the season, along with all national and international matches. Club activities were suspended for four months, before clubs were allowed to stage training nights from July onwards, albeit under restrictions set by the government. A further month passed, before clubs were allowed to hold competitive individual matches, again under restrictions. After a successful trial match, six rounds of the Manchester Individual Grand Prix series were held, at Astley & Tyldesley and Bury, during August and September. The series resulted in overall wins for Reece Pollitt in the Open section and Duncan Whalley in the u-13 category.

Some clubs staged a few open individual events, which saw Emily Burgess winning the prestigious Women's Laurels meeting at Poole and Steve Harris winning the Bob Atkinson Memorial o-35 event at Hull.

A&T rounded off the season by staging two charity BMX/ Speedway events in October, run in conjunction with riders, clubs and officials from BMX clubs in the North West and Yorkshire regions.

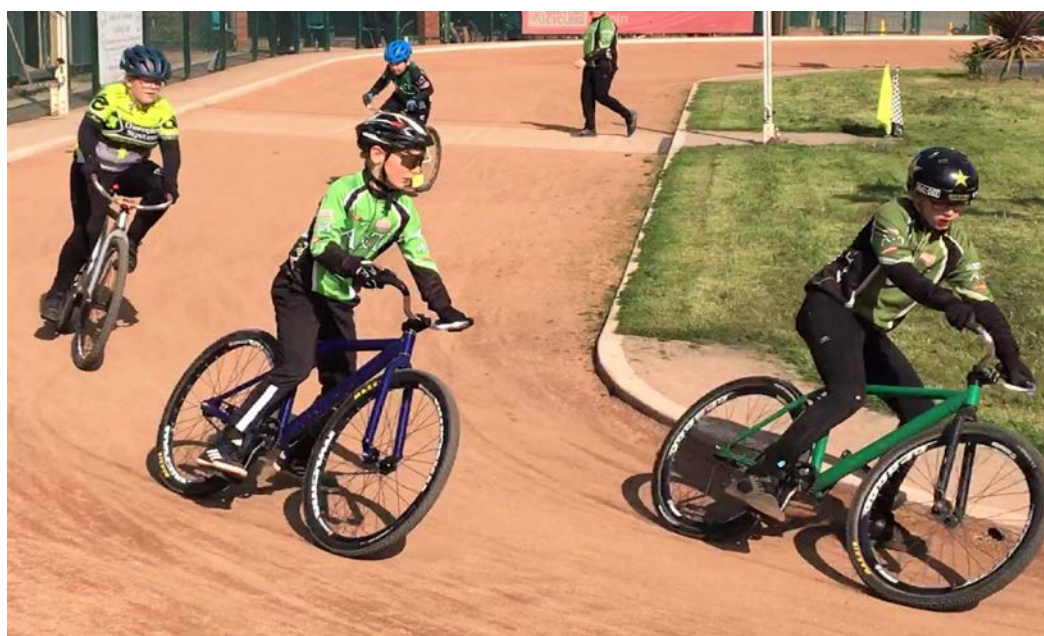
